Dear To Whom This May Concern:

Per your request for flammability information nylon cart covers, we have reviewed the Code of Federal Regulations 16 CFR 1602 to 1632, Subchapter D – Flammable Fabrics Act Regulations. At this time, there are no standards of flammability for these products. However, in 16 CFR 1610 – Standard for Flammability for Clothing Textiles states the following:

“(d) Exemptions. Experience gained from years of testing in accordance with the Standard demonstrates that certain fabrics consistently yield acceptable results when tested in accordance with the Standard. Therefore, persons and firms issuing an initial guaranty of any of the following types of fabrics, or of products made entirely from one or more of these fabrics, are exempt from any requirement for testing to support guaranties of those fabrics: (1) Plain surface fabrics, regardless of fiber content, weighing 2.6 ounces per square yard or more; and (2) All fabrics, both plain surface and raised-fiber surface, regardless of weight, made entirely from any of the following fibers or entirely from combination of the following fibers: acrylic, modacrylic, nylon, olefin, polyester, wool.”

You may wish to review your state guidelines to see if they have any additional requirements.
